Types of Constitution

There are two types of constitution in Nepal, they are as follow:

- **Written Constitution**

A written constitution is a formal document that represents the view of the constitutional agreement, the law that rules the political system and the rights of citizens and governments in a classified form.

- **Unwritten Constitution**

The unwritten constitution refers to the concept and manner that are allowed as a require part of Nepalese government, although that they are not actually in the constitution.

Our Constitution

In every country, there is a written law of a nation, which is called as a constitution. It is the fundamental part of the country, which makes and implements the law in the nation. A country runs its administrative works on the basis of constitutional law. The constitution is the written legal document, which has a law of the nation.
