#### Lesson –Tax

##### A. Study the following text and answer the following questions:

Have you ever wondered how schools and parks are built? Or who is in charge of paying for and maintaining roads? In short, you are! That is, if you are old enough to pay **taxes**. Taxes are ways that the government can collect money from its citizens to pay for things that the people need, like schools and roads. The use of taxes has been around for centuries, dating back to the first human civilizations. In ancient Mesopotamia, taxes were paid in the form of animals or goods since formal money had not yet been invented. Over the years, different forms of money were invented, and the collection of taxes continued. Today, taxes are collected in different ways and at various levels of government. Let's find out more about the collection and purpose of taxes.

Taxes take many forms, too. When you work at a **job** to make **money**, you pay **income** taxes. Depending on how much money you make, a certain **percentage** (part) of the money you make is **withheld** (kept out of your paycheck and sent to the government). When you buy things at a store, you also usually pay sales tax, which is a **percentage** of the cost of the item charged by the store. If you own **property**, you also pay **property** taxes on the value of your **property**. Paying your taxes is considered a **civic duty**, although doing so is also a requirement of the law. If you do not pay your taxes, the government agency that oversees taxes — the Internal **Revenue** Service or IRS — will require you to pay your taxes or else face penalties, such as fines or going to jail. The money you pay in taxes goes to many places. In addition to paying the salaries of government workers, your tax rupees also help to support common resources, such as **police** and **firefighters**. Tax money helps to ensure the **roads** you travel on are safe and well-maintained. Taxes fund public libraries and parks. Taxes are also used to fund many types of government programs that help the poor and less **fortunate**, as well as many schools!
