Lesson –Origin and Formation of Society

1. Study the following text and answer the following questions:

The society has been progressing since its origin. The progress has been slow and has taken a long time to shape. There are different stages of development of society. They are as follows:

- a. Hunting Age/Stone Age
- b. Animal Rearing Age
- c. Agricultural Age
- d. Industrial Age
- e. Age of Science and Technology

a. **Hunting Age/Stone Age:** In primitive society, humans used to live in a forest like wild animals. They had no idea of living in a house so that they used to live in caves and hunt animals for food. They wandered far and wide for their prey. It was not easy to hunt wild animals. They developed stone tools to hunt animals. This age is called the Stone Age or Hunting Age.

b. **Animal Rearing Age:** It was difficult to find animals to hunt. Primitive humans had to wander far and wide in course of hunting. As time passed, the idea of rearing animals developed in them. So, they began to keep animals instead of killing them. They had less trouble in getting food now. This was the Animal-rearing Age.
