Plurals for words ending in y

Remember this simple rule: The vowel sounds in English are made by the letters *a, e, i, o, u*. All the other letters make consonant sounds.

If a word has a consonant before the final *y*, then the plural ends with *ies*.

Examples: *butterfly* becomes *butterflies*
hurry becomes *hurries*
spy becomes *spies*



If the word has a vowel before the final *y*, then the plural ends with *s*.

Examples: *boy* becomes *boys*
monkey becomes *monkeys*
day becomes *days*
