Lesson –District Coordination Committee (DCC) and its Functions

Study the following text and answer the following questions:

Districts in Nepal

Districts are the administrative divisions of a country created to run the development activities for the welfare of the people. Our country was divided into 75 districts on 1 Baisakh, 2018 BS. The main objective of the division was to develop the country in a balanced way through the proper utilizing of the available means and resources. The division also aimed to increase public participation through effective administration. At present, Nepal has 77 districts after the restructure of the nation into 753 local bodies in 2074 BS. Previously existing **Nawalparasi (East Nawalparasi and West Nawalparasi)** and **Rukum (East Rukum and West Rukum)** were further divided into 2 separate districts each.

DCCs as Local-Self Government

The District Coordination Committees (DCCs) are the district-level authorities in Nepal. It means, they function as executive local bodies to the District Assembly. The DCCs were formed on 1st Chaitra, 2073 to replace the existing District Development

Committees (DDCs) because Nepal had to adopt a new structure for practising federalism as stated and function as the local self-governments under the supervision and guidance of the Ministry of Federal Affairs and Local Development.
