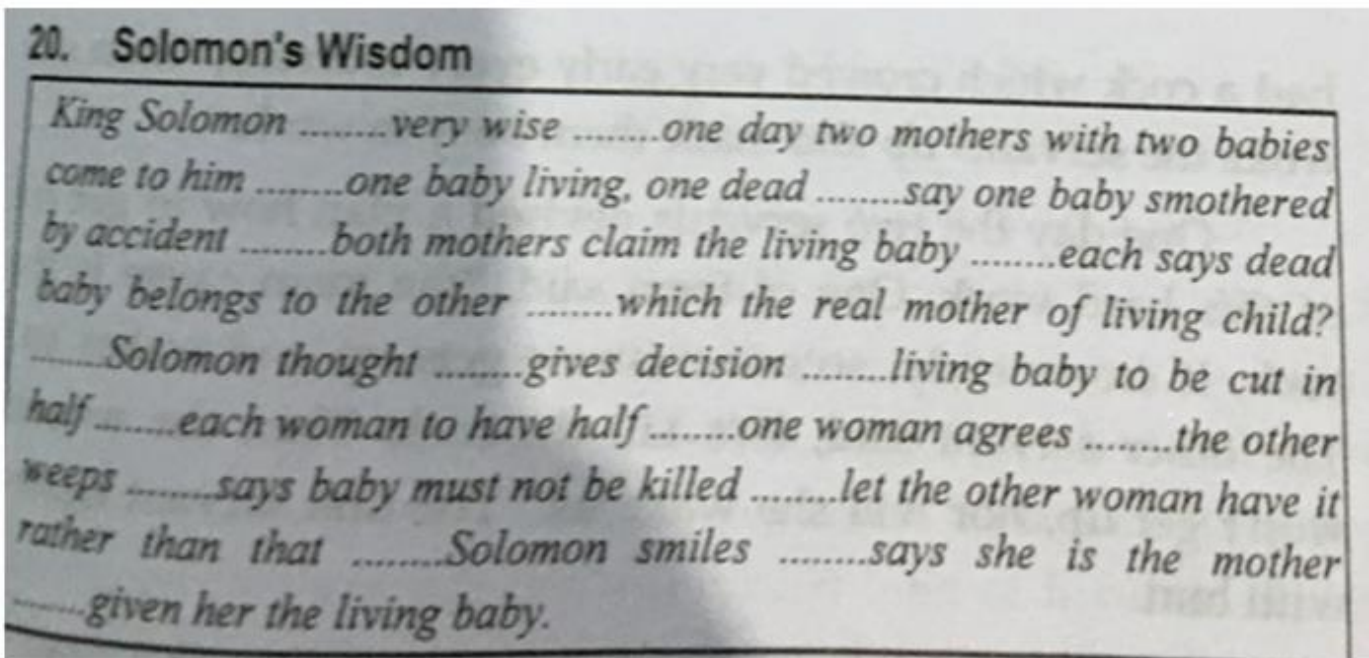
- a) Is the multiplication of natural numbers a repeated addition? Justify your answer with two examples.
