

Report Writing

Reports tell us what things are (or were) like.

They are sometimes called **non-chronological reports**. This means that they are not written in time order.



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Types of Reports

Reports can describe all kinds of subjects and topics. You can find reports in these types of texts...

- Information Leaflets
- Travel Guides
- Magazine Articles
- Encyclopedia Articles
- Non-Fiction Books



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Researching the Topic

It is tricky to write a report if you don't know much about the topic, so research it carefully before you start.

Look in your own books.



Visit the library.



Search online safely.



Interview somebody who knows the topic well.



Can you think of any other ways of researching your topic?

When you are researching, write clear notes that you can refer to later.

Make sure that you have recorded the **important facts**. Check that they are **accurate**.

Try to use the **key vocabulary** and **remove unnecessary words**.

Save time by using **symbols** and **abbreviations** that you will remember later.

Organise your notes into sections. This will help you plan the sections of your final report.

Remember to **write the facts**, not opinions.

Stick to the Facts!

Reports should be factual. They give information about a topic, so try to avoid giving personal opinions.
